- One of the largest vertically integrated Ukrainian agro-industrial holdings
- Extensive modern infrastructure:
 - Invested over USD 200 mln for the last 3 years
 - Total silo capacity of about 600,000 tons
 - Over 220,000 sq.m. of warehousing facilities
 - 41 distribution hubs all over Ukraine
- # 1 Nation-wide distributor of seeds, crop protection products, fertilisers and agricultural machinery
- One of the largest arable land banks in Ukraine (162,000 ha)
- # 1 seeds producer in Ukraine with 5 own production plants
- The most powerful sugar production plant in Ukraine: 9,000 tons of sugar beets per day, investment in modernization over USD 20 mln







Restore top position among distributors

Focus on yield improvement and operating efficiencies in Production

Optimize capital structure

- Achieve 60% annual growth in Sales and 30% growth in EBITDA of Distribution segment in 2010/11
- Restore top position among national distributors of agricultural machinery & inputs
- Leverage strong relationships with suppliers and unique distribution platform to boost sales
- Target yield improvements in corn (10%), grain (20%), oilseeds (30%) and sugar beet (20%) by 2011
